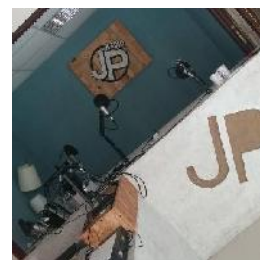

Place of the activities

Putignano, a small and nice town in the Puglia region, Italy.



Activities of the volunteer

Since 2016, Warrols signed a partnership for the management of the Urban Laboratory called “San Nicola di Genna”, from Castellana Grotte town (in the Italian Region of Puglia). This building –situated in the countryside- is an ex-school, which was recently recuperated and renovated. Warrols collaborates as well with the Radio JP webradio (<http://www.radiojp.it>) which allows many young people to manage and run their own webradio show.

In particular, the volunteers will be involved in the following activities:

- J Biodynamic agriculture educational activities for children (from 5 to 10 years old);
- J Support of the daily after-school activities for children (from 5 to 10 years old) through playful and didactical methodologies;
- J Support to the development and management of the “Nino Rota Camp” (summer camp for children);
- J Designing and management of didactical workshops for children;





- J Support for the organization of other events scheduled in the Urban Laboratory calendar;
- J When applicable, support to the ongoing extra-projects activities of Warrols;
- J Support for the broadcasting of webradio shows within the local webradio “RadioJP” (<http://www.radiojp.it>);
- J Support of the activities that RadioJP does as media partner within the local music festivals;
- J Italian language course;
- J Team building, self-reflection and self-evaluation activities.

Those activities will allow the volunteer to learn and develop new professional and soft skills, to socialize with the local people, to understand a new culture a new language, to better understand what does it mean being an European citizen, to break all the prejudices and intercultural barriers. Finally to improve as a human being.
